Terry Chase, an 18 year employee of Baron Machine in the shipping/receiving department, was diagnosed in July with a rare leukemia (CMML). Terry visited the doctor after experiencing extreme fatigue along with a pain in his left side. Shortly after, he learned he would need a marrow transplant to survive. Terry's sister is not a match and there are NO matches on the national registry. Chances of finding a perfect match are very slim. By registering to become a bone marrow donor, you are giving someone like Terry a better chance at finding a match and a second chance at life.

Tissue type is inherited so Terry's donor will most likely be similar Northern European background; however, donors from all backgrounds are needed. There are many people in need of a bone marrow transplant. In Terry's honor, please come and register to be a bone marrow donor. You could save a life!
